## Venture English Offers

### ➤ MAN-TO-MAN CLASS

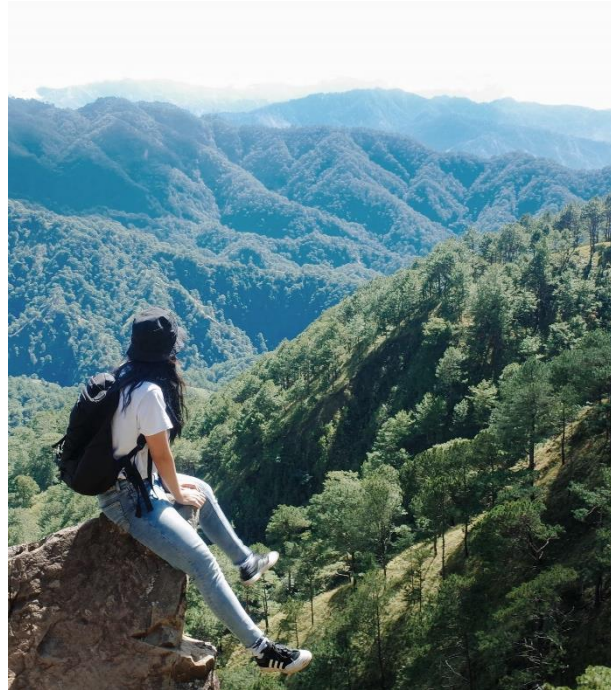
Students are given man-to-man class for a total of 20 hours for a duration of 4 weeks

### ➤ WEEKEND TRIP

Every weekend, students are sent on a mission to test their speaking fluency on certain areas such as asking for directions, ordering food, purchasing items, etc.

### ➤ BUCKET LIST BOOK

This book is a guided journal for English students and travelers that contain a number of to-do's to fully enjoy and appreciate their stay here in the Philippines.



**Venture** addresses the situations students often encounter when traveling abroad. It lays out travel- related vocabulary and expressions that students can use for their weekend missions.





## ➤ Duration

4 – 8 weeks (One book is intended for 20 hours)

- > 4 weeks : 20 class hours + weekend community Immersion
- > 8 weeks : 40 class hours + weekend community Immersion

*\* duration would depend on the completion of the mission*

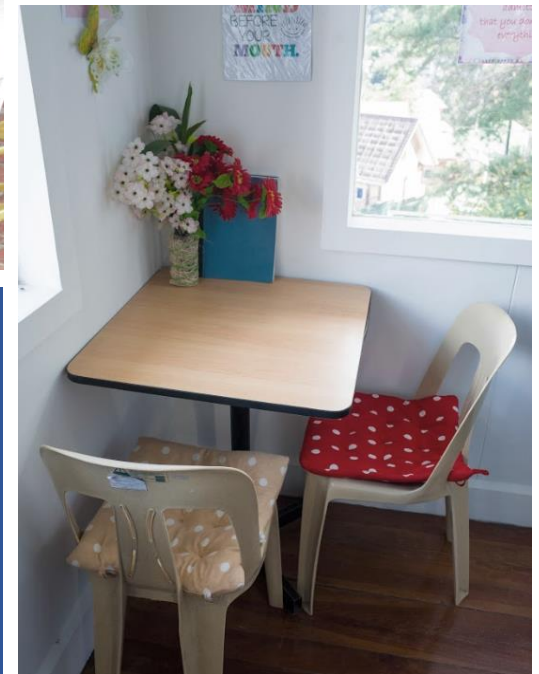
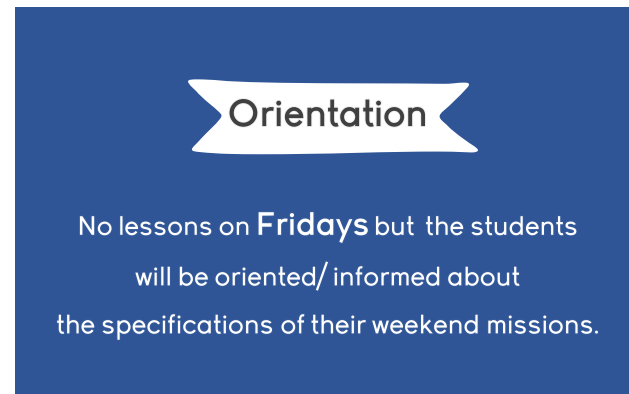
## ➤ Target Level

Basic to Intermediate

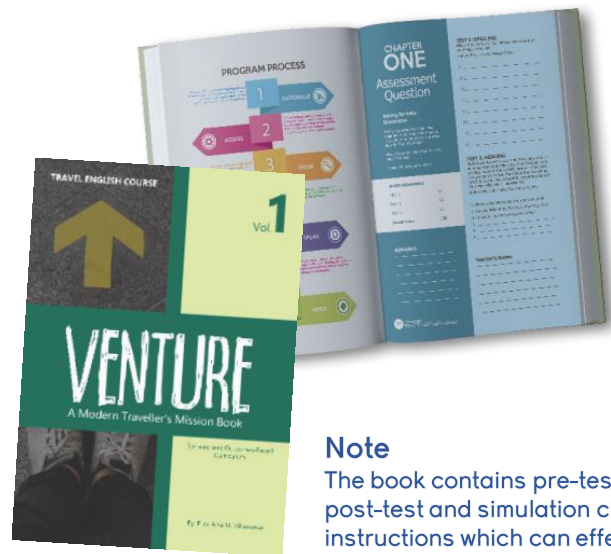

# PROGRAM MATERIALS



## Note

The book contains pre-test, post-test and simulation class instructions which can effectively monitor the progress of the student.

## 1. VENTURE TEXTBOOK

The textbook caters to students whose goal is to be able to confidently and effectively communicate in English during their travels abroad. This book also provide students a chance to make full use of their learning by accomplishing practical tasks related to the program.

The textbook incorporates a systematic pedagogy with the following features:

- **OBJECTIVES** : Enumerates the purpose of the lessons in each chapter.
- **KNOW** : Provides must-know vocabulary, idioms, expressions and phrases before progressing to sentence formation.
- **SPEAK** : Contains sample conversations that will guide the learner to build up their own conversation.
- **LISTEN** : The speaker is a teacher (non-virtual speaker) making the listening class closer to real life conversations and improving their listening comprehension.
- **APPLY** : Contains instructional scenarios where the learner is placed in a "world" defined by the teacher and represents a reality within which students interact. The teacher controls the parameters of this "world" and uses it to achieve the desired instructional results.

# PROGRAM MATERIALS



## 2. BUCKET LIST BOOK

It is a book that contains missions which students must be able complete within a given period of time (usually one weekend). Also, a space is provided where they can write their experience on the weekend. The accomplishment of this book shall be monitored by an assigned teacher or their man-to-man teacher.

\*Weekend mission – activities to be accomplished on the weekends
